



 The total number of IISMA awardees in 2021 and 2022 (heading to the Netherlands)



Indonesia – the Netherlands Cooperation in Vocational Education

Orange Knowledge Programme (OKP) Tailor Made Training + (TMT+)

- The training is specifically dedicated to support the Center of Excellence (SMK PK) in agriculture programme developed by the Directorate General of Vocational Education.
- The training beneficiaries encompass **10** Centers of Excellence that specialise Competencies for Food Crops, Horticulture, and Poultry Livestock Agribusiness.
- The OKP TMT+ training was implemented by appointing a consortium consisting of representatives from Indonesia and the Netherlands, namely the Bogor Agricultural Institute, BBPMPPV for Agriculture in Cianjur, Wageningen University, Zone College, Van Hall Larenstein, and HollandDoor.
- The training focuses on human resources and institulitionalisation development through enhancement in partnerships with the work field. One of the training agendas is the Inspirational Tour Educational and Sector Innovations which was held at Wageningen University, the Netherlands on June 15-24, 2022.
- The Tour was attended by 10 Heads of Vocational Senior Secondary Schools completing the TMT+ training, as well as 3 representatives from the Directorate General of Vocational Education, MoECRT.

Collaboration in Green Education (2nd phase)

- Following the success of the first phase of Collaboration in Green Education piloted in SMKN 2 Subang and SMKN 5 Jember, Technical Arrangement for the same initiative (Green Education: Revitalization of Technical and Vocational Education and Training [TVET]) was signed in June 2021.
- In this second phase, the scope of the collaboration includes institutional strengthening: link and match with the industrial sector (Triple Helix Forum), curriculum development, school management training, technology-based agricultural innovation, increased productivity and efficiency, sustainable food production, and promotion of the agricultural sector to young generation.
- Following to the signing of the Technical Arrangement, a Steering Committee for Green Education (SCGE) meeting was held on November 21, 2021, and February 22, 2022.
- The meeting came with an agreement that future cooperation with the Dutch Government will explore initiatives of supporting the food state programme in North Sumatra (Humbang Hasundutan).


